#### 1. Borrell Family

- 801 **Joseph Turner** a coal miner = **Anna Maria Wright**  
 802 **Emma Wright Turner** born 16 January 1861 at Netherton Hill,  
 Dudley, in Worcestershire = **Cash Borrill** # 809

\*\*\*\*\*

- 803 **John Evis** born 1834 at Taunton. He moved to North  
 Petherton, then to Bridgewater where he was a basketmaker =  
**Sarah** born 1823 at North Petherton. Louisa was their  
 eldest child, followed by Samuel, Sydney and Jane  
 804 **Louisa Evis** born 1863 at North Petherton in Somerset. In  
 the 1881 census return she was shown as a domestic  
 assistant to her father = **Thomas Henry Love** # 806

- 805 **Henry Love** Lived at Bethnel Green  
 806 **Thomas Henry Love** born 1863 at Bethnel Green. In the 1881  
 Census he was described as a book binder's apprentice. In  
 1895 he was described as a Coppersmith. At the time of his  
 daughter Lily's wedding in 1919 his occupation was given as  
 Sheet Metal Worker = **Louisa Evis** # 804  
 807 **Lily Louisa Love** born 27 January 1895 at 2 Manchester  
 Buildings, East Street in Walworth = **Alfred Dunstan Borrell**  
 # 810

 Note; the name of Borrell has been variously spelt according to  
 how it was heard, written or given - Borrell, Borrill, Borril,  
 Burrel, Burrill,

- 808 **Edward Borrill** born about 1813 at Caistor in Lincolnshire.  
 About 1841 he moved with Mary to Caerwent in South Wales  
 where their first child, Elizabeth, was born, then in 1842  
 he brought Mary back to Caistor where they were married.  
 They went back then to live at Caerwent until about 1848,  
 where James (1843), Jane (1845) and Mary (1847) were born.  
 Returning to Lincolnshire they lived at Osgodby where other  
 children were born, Charlotte (1850), Emma (1853), Edward  
 (1858) and Cash (1859). At the time of the wedding of his  
 son Cash, in 1880, Edward was shown as a labourer. His  
 name on the marriage certificate is shown as Borrell, but  
 this is the writing of the clergyman = **Mary Carr** born at  
 Market Rasen about 1821  
 809 **Cash Borrill**, a shepherd, born at Caister (or Seerby,  
 according to Census return). At the time of his wedding to  
 Emma his residence was given as Osgodby and his occupation  
 as Labourer, and although he signed himself Cash Borrill  
 the clergyman entered it spelt Borrell. At the time of his  
 son Alfred's wedding in 1919 his occupation was given as  
 farm labourer = **Emma Wright Turner** They were married 8  
 December 1880 at the parish church of Kirkby-cum-Osgodby  
 and their witnesses were Alfred Davis (is this the Alfred  
 after whom Alfred Dunstan was named?) and Sarah Ann Davis#

## 2. Borrell family

- 802
- 810 **Alfred Dunstan Borrell**, born 19 May 1890 at Middle Rasen in Lincolnshire. At the time of his marriage in 1919 he was a Staff Sergeant of the Royal Army Veterinary Corps and his address was given at that time as New End Military Hospital in Hampstead = **Lily Louisa Love**. They were married 3 August 1919 at the Dulwich Grove Congregational Church in Camberwell, at which time her address was 2 Constance Road, East Dulwich # 807
- 811 **Audrey Margaret Borrell** born 11 July 1932 = **Paul Frederick Middleton**
- 812 **Adrian Paul Borrell Middleton**
